Edenbridge Piranhas Swimming Club will actively encourage its members to avoid the use of any type of drugs, with the exception of prescribed medications. Parents and guardians are requested to inform the club if swimmers are taking any prescribed medication on the membership application form. Any member suspected of using any type of prohibited drug will be suspended with immediate effect and will not be reinstated until a full investigation has been carried out by the disciplinary panel as per the Clubs Complaints and Disciplinary Procedure.
